Role Description for: Boat Captain

Responsibilities.

General Responsibilities

- Leads and role models a safe and healthy culture that brings all members together to support the development of lifeguards, future lifeguards, athletes, and the provision of lifeguard services.
- Create an annual surf boat budget for committee approval
- Manages, in accordance with the agreed budget, any expenses for surf boat equipment
- Create a surf boat leadership group and engage with them throughout the season
- Align decisions and activities to the Surf Boat goals and Principle's document. Update and seek approval from the committee as needed.
- Contribute to the Club's Annual Calendar.
- Report any risks or incidents to the Chair
- Inform Lifesaving Co-ordinator of new members that require lifeguard training. Refer potential new members to appropriate coordinator.

Athlete development

- Create an agreed plan for each year for the direction of the Boat programme that includes opportunities for all surf boat athletes to excel in their sport.
- Create a learning environment for both sweeps and athletes.
- Co-opt expertise to further develop skills.

Crew selection and development

- Create and oversee surf boat crew selection processes
- Lead the training of new sweeps
- Support sweeps as needed throughout the season
- Provide training programmes for crews as required

Surf boats and equipment

- Lead the maintenance and upkeep of surf boat equipment
- Allocate surf boat gear throughout the season
- Maintain relationships with equipment suppliers
- Raise grant applications for additional equipment when required.

Competitions

- Enters crew entries into competitions and enter crews through WAVES.
- Liaise with SLSNZ Central Region Sport Manager regarding hosting of any surf boat competitions
- Maintain 'Titahi Bay Boaties' Facebook page as a tool for communicating with athletes and their families
- Coordinate competition travel with crews

Health and Safety

- Ensures that the surf boat arena acts within the SLSNZ policies and procedures.
- Ensure that the surf boat program complies with the club's Child protection policy.
- Ensure that Sweeps over the age of 18 have been police vetted and that they have completed the SLSNZ Safeguarding Children online module.
- Ensure SiteDocs is completed before each training session.

Fundraising

Oversee fundraising activities, develop a fundraising plan, and ensure funds are spent in accordance to the plan.

Other

- Delegate but remain accountable for any of the above duties
- Undertake any other activities as required by the Committee.
